With comfortable lodges or camps, private transport, and expert guiding, this safari offers a balanced mix of wildlife viewing, scenery, and memorable moments across Tanzania's northern safari circuit.

Day 1

Day 1: Arrival in Arusha

Meals: Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha hotel or lodge

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport or Arusha Airport, you will be met by a representative from Travel Hype Adventures and transferred to your hotel in Arusha. Depending on your arrival time, you can relax after your journey and receive a short safari briefing about the days ahead. This first evening gives you time to settle in and prepare for your northern circuit adventure.

Day 2

Day 2: Arusha to Tarangire National Park

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire lodge or camp

After breakfast, depart Arusha and drive to Tarangire National Park, a beautiful park known for its giant baobab trees, open savannah, and impressive elephant population. You will enjoy your first full game drive while exploring the Tarangire River area, where many animals gather, especially in the dry season. Expect to see elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, impalas, and a variety of birdlife, with possible sightings of lions and leopards.

Day 3

Day 3: Full Day in Tarangire National Park

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire lodge or camp

Spend a full day discovering more of Tarangire's diverse habitats and quiet wildlife-rich corners. With extra time in the park, your guide can explore beyond the main tracks and follow animal activity through different sections of the reserve. The park's combination of riverine woodland, grassy plains, and seasonal swamps creates excellent opportunities for photography and rewarding game viewing throughout the day.

Day 4: Tarangire to Central Serengeti

Day 4

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Central Serengeti camp or lodge

After breakfast, begin your journey toward Serengeti National Park, passing through the scenic highlands and the Ngorongoro area on the way. As you enter Serengeti, the landscape opens into the famous endless plains that have made the park legendary. Enjoy an en-route game drive as you head to your camp or lodge, with chances to spot zebras, gazelles, giraffes, big cats, and, depending on the season, large herds of wildebeest.

Day 5: Full Day Game Drive in Serengeti

Day 5

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Central Serengeti camp or lodge

Today is dedicated to exploring the Serengeti in depth. You will head out with picnic lunch for a full day of game viewing across one of Africa's greatest wildlife areas. The Serengeti is famous for its predators, including lions, cheetahs, and leopards, as well as its huge populations of herbivores. Your guide will adjust the route based on recent wildlife movements and sightings to maximize the experience.

Day 6: Another Full Day in Serengeti

Day 6

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Central Serengeti camp or lodge

A second full day in Serengeti allows for a more relaxed pace and greater flexibility in searching for wildlife. You may explore different areas of the park, follow the migration route depending on the season, or spend time near kopjes and river systems where predators are often active. This extra day adds depth to the safari and increases your chances of seeing special sightings and varied animal behavior.

Day 7: Serengeti to Ngorongoro Conservation Area

Day 7

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro / Karatu lodge

After breakfast, enjoy a final morning game drive in Serengeti before continuing toward the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The drive offers more wildlife viewing and changing scenery as you

leave the plains behind and move toward the crater highlands. Arrive at your lodge near the crater rim or in Karatu in time to relax and prepare for the next day's descent into the world-famous Ngorongoro Crater.

Day 8: Ngorongoro Crater Game Drive

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Karatu lodge

Descend early into the Ngorongoro Crater for one of the most remarkable safari experiences in Tanzania. The crater floor supports a dense concentration of wildlife and offers very good chances of seeing lions, buffaloes, zebras, wildebeest, hyenas, hippos, and many bird species. With luck, you may also spot the endangered black rhino. After a rewarding game drive and picnic lunch, ascend the crater and continue to your overnight stay.

Day 9: Lake Manyara National Park

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Lake Manyara / Karatu lodge

Today you visit Lake Manyara National Park, a compact but scenic park known for its groundwater forest, acacia woodland, lake shore, and varied wildlife. The park is home to elephants, baboons, giraffes, buffaloes, hippos, and an excellent range of birdlife, especially around the lake. It is also famous for its tree-climbing lions, although sightings are never guaranteed. The variety of habitats makes this a refreshing final wildlife stop on the safari.
