### Arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport

### Machame Gate to Machame Camp

#### Day 2

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Machame Camp (camping)

After breakfast, drive to Machame Gate to complete park formalities.r

Begin the climb through dense rainforest where you may see monkeys and tropical vegetation.r

What to expect: Forest trail, muddy sections, and gradual ascent.rnr

### Day 3 **Machame Camp to Shira Camp**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Shira Camp (camping)

Leave the forest behind and climb into heath and moorland zones.r

The trail opens to wide views of the Shira Plateau and surrounding landscapes.r

What to expect: Cooler temperatures, open scenery, and steady uphill walking.rnr

### Day 4 **Shira Camp to Barranco Camp (via Lava Tower)**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Barranco Camp (camping)

Climb higher toward Lava Tower for acclimatization before descending to Barranco Camp.r

This day follows the u201cclimb high, sleep lowu201d principle to help your body adjust.r

What to expect: Thin air at higher altitude and improved acclimatization overnight.rnr

### Day 5 **Barranco Camp to Karanga Camp**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Karanga Camp (camping)

After breakfast, climb the famous Barranco Wall, a steep but non-technical scramble.r

Continue across ridges and valleys toward Karanga Camp.r

What to expect: Exciting climb, great views, and a shorter hiking day.rnr

### Day 6 **Karanga Camp to Barafu Camp & Summit Night**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Barafu Camp (camping)

Climb steadily to Barafu Camp, your base camp for the summit attempt.

After early dinner, rest before the midnight summit push.

What to expect: Cold temperatures, preparation for summit night, early rest.

## Day 7

### Summit Day u2013 Barafu Camp to Uhuru Peak & Descent

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Accommodation: Hotel in Moshi or Arusha

Begin the summit climb around midnight toward Uhuru Peak, the highest point in Africa.

After reaching the summit at sunrise, descend to lower altitude for recovery.

What to expect: Challenging climb, emotional summit moment, long descent.
